## Jesus Christ the King

**TRIDUUM NOVENA** for our Parish Feast Day - Masses Dec 5 - 7 will include a novena.

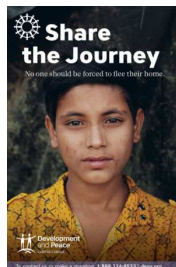
**ADVENT RECONCILIATION** - Wednesday December 5<sup>th</sup> St. Joseph students 1:00 pm and parish at 7:00 pm.

(continued from front cover) The suffering and disorder of today are a result of what was started by those chosen people. This is not just disobedience to God but a total and direct rejection of God. Disobeying God's commandments is sin that leads to death (Rom. 6:16).

Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King. In the Gospel, Jesus tells Pilate that the sole purpose of Christ's coming was to testify to the truth (v.37) that God is King. "God is King over all the earth"(Ps 47:8). It is a truth and a genuine reminder that God is our only King. The Israelites' painful lessons serve as warning to us. Doing it our way, instead of God's way will surely have tragic and fatal consequences; either death or eternal damnation.

The choice is ours. God will not prevent us from exercising our free will. God's way leads to righteousness and salvation (Rom. 6:16). Jesus as our true and only King asks obedience from us so that we may have fullness of life and salvation. This was expressed by St. Mark (10:45) "*The Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and give his life as a ransom for many*". Love and service are the marks of true followers of Jesus and members of His eternal, victorious and glorious kingdom. The Lord sits as King Forever. The Lord will bless His people with peace. 
