Epiphany of the Lord ~ 2019 January 6th

The Manifestations of Jesus Christ

Who will believe the tale of shepherds, about angels singing in a dark winter night? It was the Wise Men in all their royal splendor and fame. The feast of Epiphany completes the Christmas celebration. Without it, Christmas would have been a local and ordinary event. It gives universal character and special significance to the birth of Jesus Christ. It is not about the bright star, nor the kings or even the wise men with their precious gifts. It is still about the newborn Savior. It is the Manifestation of the Lord, for in reality He is the Savior of the world not only of Israel as expressed in Ps 72 “*Lord, every nation on earth will adore you.*”

This feast means that the coming of the Wise Men from the East is the sign and symbol that Jesus was born not only for the Jewish, but also for the Gentiles and for all humanity. That in the fullness of time, in His eternal wisdom decided to become man and became visible and comprehensible to man. It is because He manifested himself to us through Jesus, the newly born man.

In the letter of St. Paul to the Philippians 2:6-7 is described Jesus as true man yet with the presence of Wise Men coming to Him, an act not ordinary to a baby, He takes on the role of a newborn King of the Jews, therefore ‘*they prostrated themselves and did Him homage*’ (Matthew 2.2).
