Baptism of the Lord ~ 2019 January 13th

Baptism of Our Lord Jesus

This Sunday is the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. This celebration is still part of Jesus' manifestation to the world. The Gospel specifically revealed the Three Divine Persons in One God, the Holy Trinity. Yet it was only St. John the Baptist who witnesses the manifestation because he possesses the gift of vision, strengthened by the gift of faith and a transformative heart.

This celebration too reminds us to consider of our own baptism. For some, it is just one religious ceremony but for others a fundamental change in our identity. From being just a son/daughter of our own parents, in Baptism, we exhibit the characteristics of God having His very identity as a benchmark of our life; "so be perfect, just as your heavenly Father is perfect" (Mt. 5:48). We are to live and act according to our Christian dignity, infused with Christian spirit and values. We should live as citizens of heaven living up to our identity of being in this world but not of this world. So, we must conform ourselves not with the standards of this world, but with the standard of God. For our faith determines the quality of life we lead.

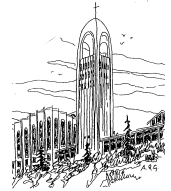

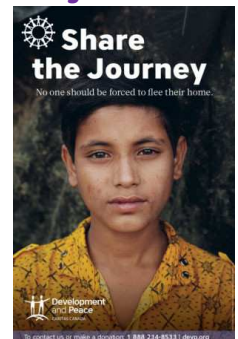

As St. Gregory of Nazianzen tells us: “*He comes to bury sinful humanity in the waters. He comes to sanctify the Jordan for our sake.*” Jesus made holy the waters of the earth so that we, through baptism are cleansed and sanctified.
