The Glory of God

A little boy wanted to visit the place where heaven and earth meet. He could see it quite plainly from his cottage window and he thought it must be very beautiful. With his eyes fixed on the horizon, the 'meeting place of heaven and earth', he began to walk. He walked on and on until he became very tired. He found himself in a valley where the horizon was hidden from his view. A cottage was near, and a woman was standing in the door. He told her of his quest, and she pointed out a house not so very far away. "There it is," she said, "only hurry; it will soon be dark." He hurried on and was soon climbing the hill that led to his own home. And there in the doorway was his mother waiting to welcome him. "My own home," he thought to himself, "the place where heaven and earth meet."

We want to find happiness. This is the reason why we want to go to heaven, a place of happiness. But heaven is not a place but a *state of being---being with God, being with Jesus*; the very experience of apostles Peter, James & John on Mt. Tabor. They experienced heaven because they saw the glory of Jesus--- his face is brighter than the sun and his clothes dazzling white. They also see Moses and Elijah conversing with him hearing the Father saying: "This is my Son, my Chosen; listen to him" (v.35). This experience is a taste of heaven and they wish to remain there forever.

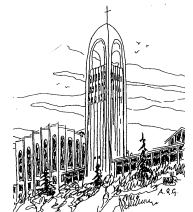

(continued from front cover) The purpose of experiencing heaven, of the transfiguration was to make the apostles aware of the divine presence in the man with whom they walked and talked. It was revealed to them giving them a taste of future glory, *heaven*. Experience teaches us that nothing worthwhile in life is ever simple, a 'short cut' to glory. Real happiness and peace of mind only come after Calvary because the cross and suffering are inescapable. Jesus showed mankind the beauty of heaven that took place after His dying on the cross. Like Elisha, people of God pray too, "Lord, open our eyes that we may see."

During this season of Lent, Jesus invites us to Him through prayer and fasting because being with Him is being with God. Jesus does not change the world but He can transform our hearts if we let Him. We will be brighter if we are tuned into the God-like image we are meant to reflect. The transfiguration is about letting the glory of God shine through us so that others can catch a glimpse of that glory.

Let us make more time to pray and to listen to Jesus so that there is nothing to fear, for we know God is with us now and for always! Amen. - Fr. Neil
