Spiritual Rock

“They drank from the spiritual rock that followed them, and the rock was Christ.” (1 Corinthians 10.4)

In 2011, on the 18th of December my parents were here in Canada to visit me and we heard the news from our home city in the Philippines - the great storm causing much devastation called “Sendong”. It struck the people of Cagayan de Oro and neighboring areas, surprising residents while they were asleep.

“Sendong” has become one of the Philippines’ worst natural disasters in two decades, with more than 1,000 people killed and the same number still missing. It was also considered the worst storm of 2011.

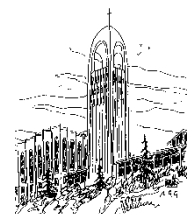
