Where Are They?

The scenario in this Sunday's Gospel reading is about the woman allegedly caught in adultery; ordinary sin. Something is missing in her life, making her deeply unhappy; perhaps a secure future, a loving husband, or even care of friends. Whatever is missing, she tries to find it in the wrong way. It is a real problem in her life, but she is about to lose her very life in trying to fix it. Adultery always makes for scandalous headlines. It threatens acceptable standards of behaviour. The Pharisees with resentful and bitter hearts are dragging a woman, caught in the act of adultery before Jesus, with no regard for her as a person, but as bait to trap Jesus.

It is a situation that, if Jesus approves of her death, the crowd will kill her outright and the Roman authorities can apprehend Jesus for inciting the crowd. On the other hand, if he does not, he will be judged as too lenient and not following the Law of Moses. Then, he will lose his credibility as prophet. But Jesus avoids the confrontation and goes to the heart of the problem saying; "Let anyone among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her." (Jn. 8:7). (continued on back cover)

(continued from front cover) The accusers drift away in embarrassment leaving the woman alone with Jesus in mute repentance. Without condoning her actions, Jesus restores her peace and friendship with God. This is the mission of Jesus: to restore mankind to his original beauty and dignity and put the world back in order. He says: "I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly" (Jn. 10:10)

With this story, we are reminded forcefully of the readiness of God to forgive sin, bind up broken lives and restore people to his friendship. He has come to heal our wounds, not accuse and condemn us but to bring unity and reconciliation, not enmity and division. The lesson is not that sin is unimportant, but that God in His goodness pardons the sinner. The mercy of God has no equal as shown in Jesus Christ who took the weight of our sins upon Himself and gave His life for us on Calvary.

Lent is an invitation to take a close look at our lives, acknowledging our weaknesses and start anew in our friendship with God. May this Holy Week provide us with the graces we need to follow Jesus our King, for in dying on the cross, we are assured of victory and fullness of life. Gaudium et Spes, 22 states; "By suffering for us He not only provided us with an example for our imitation, He blazed a trail, and if we follow it, life and death are made holy and take on a new meaning". "Jesus said, Where are they? Neither do I condemn you"
