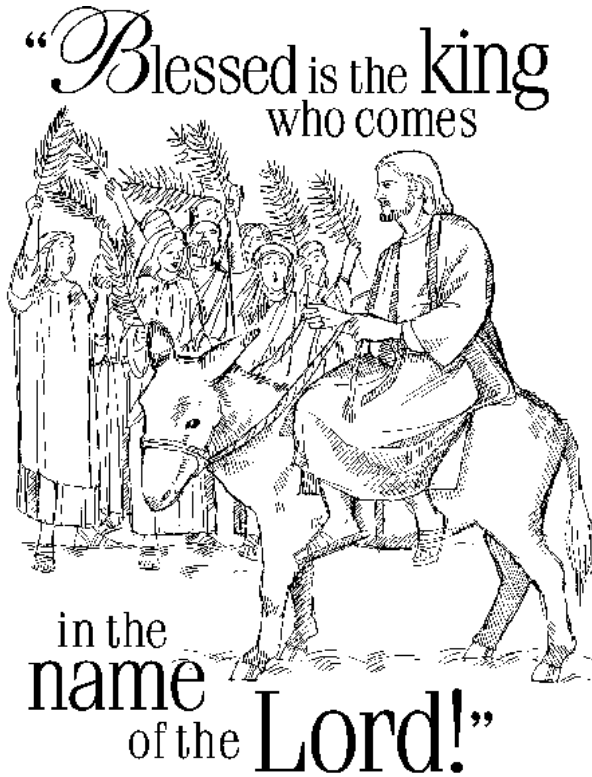

Passion Sunday

In his letters, St. Francis of Sales tells about a custom where he lived. He had often noticed a servant going to draw water at the well. He also noticed that, before she lifted the brimming pail, the girl always put a piece of wood into it. One day he went out to the girl and asked her, “Why do you do that?” she looked surprised and answered, as if it were a matter of course, “Why? to keep the water from spilling, to keep it steady.” Writing to a friend later on, the bishop told this story and added, “So when your heart is distressed and agitated, put the CROSS into its center to keep it steady.”

Today, we commemorate the “Sunday of our Lord’s Passion”, the First day of the Holy Week, the most sacred time in the church year, the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem. They proclaimed: “*Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord*” (Lk 19:37-38) and “*Hosanna to the Son of David*”. Jesus Christ has no illusions about this fickle crowd as the week unfolds, the palm branches shape themselves into a cross and the hosannas become the jeers of a treacherous mob calling for His death.

(continued from front cover) The passion presents the ultimate humbling of Jesus, involving far more than the physical cruelty of the crucifixion. There was terror and agony of mind and heart to be endured and this pain was so intense that his sweat became like drops of blood, long before the nails were driven into his body on the cross. The loneliness and isolation which he felt when friends deserted him on Calvary Hill was nothing to being abandoned by the Father: "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

As followers of Jesus, we should be fully aware of the kind of kingship He represents. His Kingship clearly shows: a Kingship not of division but of unity and inclusive fellowship; not a desire to dominate but to serve; not of violence but healing; not of accusation but forgiveness; not of selfishness but love.

This final week of Lent is a great opportunity to celebrate in a way that will change our lives. We must never forget that Jesus died on the cross so that we might have new life! Let this Holy week provide us with the graces we need in order to follow our King, Jesus Christ! As Gaudium et Epes states, "By suffering for us He not only provided us with an example for our imitation, He blazed a trail, and if we follow it, life and death are made holy and take on a new meaning". May we have all a blessed and meaningful Holy Week! Amen. ~ Fr. Neil
