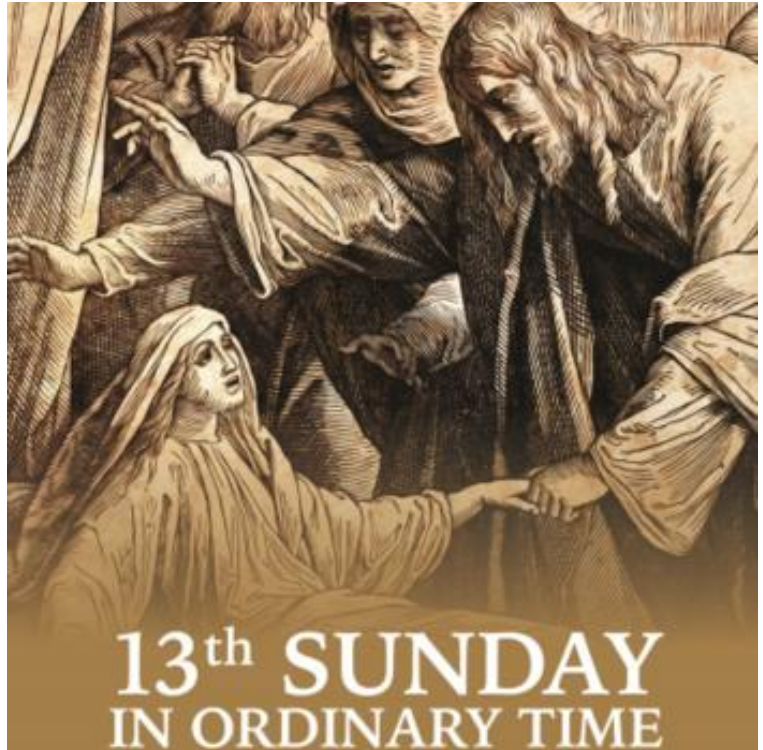

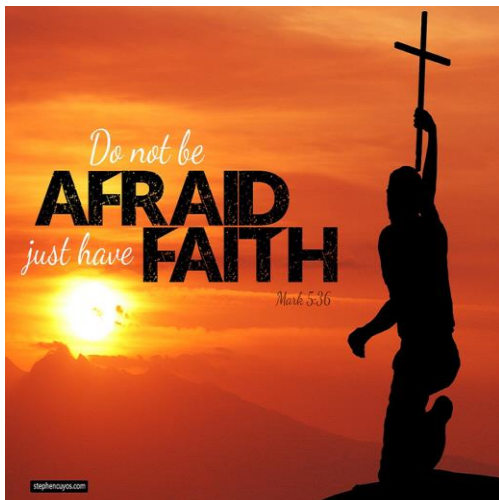

The entire life of Jesus, from his birth to his death on the cross, is according to the overall plan of God for the salvation of the world. The Gospel this Sunday, Jesus is "resolutely determined to journey to Jerusalem" (v.51). He goes to Jerusalem not a tourist or visitor. He is going there to accomplish the plan of God the Father. It is there that he will undergo sufferings and death and offer his life for the salvation of all. His obedience to the heavenly Father is absolute and immutable. No one can change His decision to follow His Father's will, not the hostility of the Samaritans nor the objections of Peter and the pleadings of His disciples.

The call and the cost of Christian commitment are heavily emphasised in this Gospel where the life of discipleship and its qualities are laid before us. There is nothing about being a follower of Jesus that does not demand effort. As all existing responsibilities have to take second place. Jesus is only fair when He makes it clear in very direct speech what is expected if those who wish to join His group. If we want to accompany Jesus we must know what we are doing and be aware of the harsh realities of life. The message is clear- if anything at all stands in our way or takes priority in our lives, then we are free to follow Him.
