New Directives as COVID-19 Worsens

23 November 2020

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Greetings in the Lord!

As you have heard, new orders were recently issued from the Provincial Health Authorities that restrict our gathering as a Faith community to celebrate Mass in-person.

This is very discouraging since all of you have been so faithful in following our diocesan COVID protocols and precautions. Up to this point, we have not had an exposure or outbreak in any of our parishes, thanks be to God and to you. I couldn't be more grateful for you and for all you have done to keep our parishes safe.

Since the Eucharist is central to our Faith, it is important to note that Mass will continue to be celebrated and offered for you and your intentions. Please check your parish or the diocesan website for live-streamed Mass information. I have also given permission to have Holy Communion available for the faithful who attend Mass virtually. The procedure to receive Holy Communion in your car after Mass is as follows:

Wait in your car in the parking lot. When the priest comes to your car, roll down your window, extend your hand to receive Holy Communion, remove your mask, and consume the Eucharist

Please note that our parishes remain open for prayer and visits to the Blessed Sacrament. Your parishes will also continue to offer the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Please continue to observe our COVID protocols and precautions.

Now is not the time to give in to our frustration and anger. It is important we acknowledge our feelings, but direct them to something positive, such as becoming more prayerful or patient or thankful. It might even mean writing the Provincial Health Officer or your elected officials to voice your concerns over Mass restrictions.

If one thing the pandemic has taught us, we need to continually work at being a people of Faith, Hope and Love.




Waiting in Joyful Hope

Isaiah 63.16b-17; 64.1,3-8 1 Corinthians 1.3-9 Mark 13.33-37

The First Sunday of Advent marks the beginning of a new Church liturgical year, calling for vigilance yet brimming with hope. This season reminds us that we have to make preparations for the deeper meaning of Christmas. God's presence among His people in the person of Jesus Christ. His coming on Christmas Day fills us with hope, and gives us encouragement that amidst all life's depressing and difficult realities, broken families, growing poverty, disenchanted youth, random violence, proliferation of illegal drugs and most recent experience of covid19 which shows nothing changes at all, our future is secure because it is in God's hands.

The non-stop calling throughout the readings is the warning, **Beware, keep alert: for you do not know when the time will come**," is a grim reminder that the day of reckoning lies ahead. The real challenge of Advent is to prepare yourself in body, in spirit and soul for that great encounter, by letting God's presence and power to get to work in our lives. For God's unfathomable love has been manifested in the unique gift of His Incarnate Son, Jesus, Emmanuel, God-with-us. He makes us aware that life is incomplete without God and we are useless without His presence for He alone can satisfy our deepest longings and fill us with inner peace and wholeness. God alone is our hope even within a broken world, a wounded humanity. It is a great time for soul searching and renewal, for asking pardon and forgiveness, and for begging Him to save us and stay with us.

We are invited to listen to the voice of God in countless ways He speaks to us every moment. There is no single minute when He does not knock at the door of your and my hearts. Thus, one way we can let Him in is by being a neighbour in our community and availing the opportunities to serve especially to the lowly and bring them the joys of Jesus Christ. Let us do the good now and what good we have to do for while. Advent is about waiting for God to come into our lives, it is good to remember that God has been waiting for us longer than we have been waiting for Him. Advent is here - let us wait in Joyful Hope! "Restore is, O God: let your face shine, that we may be saved." (Psalm 80) AMEN.


